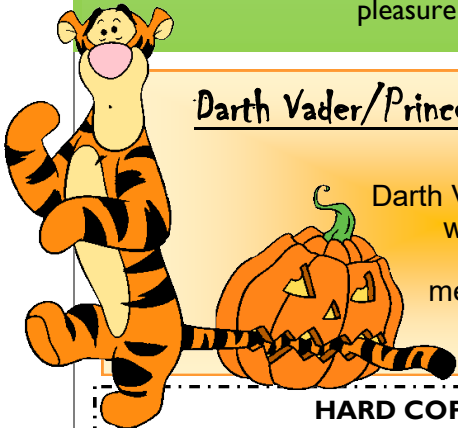
Terry Fox Run
