Custom School Supplies

2025/26 Homeroom Notification: Change

As we approach the end of the school year, we want to inform you of an important update regarding report cards and class placements. On your child's final report card, the teacher will indicate the grade level your child will be in next year but specific class placements, such as classroom teacher, will not be included. Instead, you will receive an email on Thursday, August 28, 2025 from your child's teacher with information about their class for the upcoming school year.

We've made this change due to the number of new student registrations we receive over the summer. In the past, these late changes have required us to adjust classes and teacher assignments at the last minute which can be difficult for students and parents.
